A number of hedge funds have recently modified their holdings of PBW. ... raised its holdings in shares of Invesco WilderHill Clean Energy ETF by 111.0% in the 2nd quarter. ... now owns 244,855 shares of the company's stock worth \$11,192,000 after purchasing an additional 128,818 shares during the period. ... raised its holdings in Invesco WilderHill Clean Energy ETF by 16.9% during the 3rd quarter. ... now owns 361,291 shares of the company's stock valued at \$17,407,000 after acquiring an additional 52,312 shares during the period. ... raised its holdings in Invesco WilderHill Clean Energy ETF by 445.6% during the 1st quarter. ... now owns 43,100 shares of the company's stock valued at \$2,808,000 after acquiring an additional 35,200 shares during the period. ... bought a new stake in Invesco WilderHill Clean Energy ETF during the 1st quarter valued at \$1,384,000.
