## **Thursday's ETF with Unusual Volume: PBD**

The Global Clean Energy Portfolio ETF (PBD) is seeing unusually high volume in afternoon trading Thursday, with over 281,000 shares traded versus three month average volume of about 55,000. Shares of PBD were up about 0.6% on the day.

Components of that ETF with the highest volume on Thursday were Molycorp (MCP), trading up about 0.5% with over 3.7 million shares changing hands so far this session, and JA Solar Holdings Limited Ads (JASO), down about 1.2% on volume of over 3.6 million shares. Lsb Industries (LXU) is the component faring the best Thursday, higher by about 6.9% on the day, while Polypore International (PPO) is lagging other components of the Global Clean Energy Portfolio ETF, trading lower by about 5%
